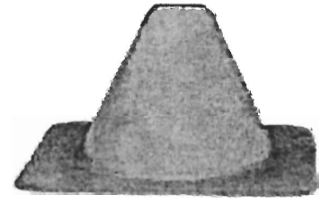
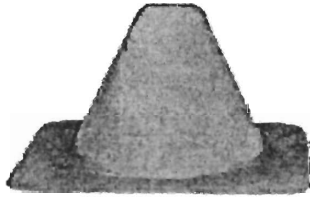

- 3) How long have you been a member of Spokes?

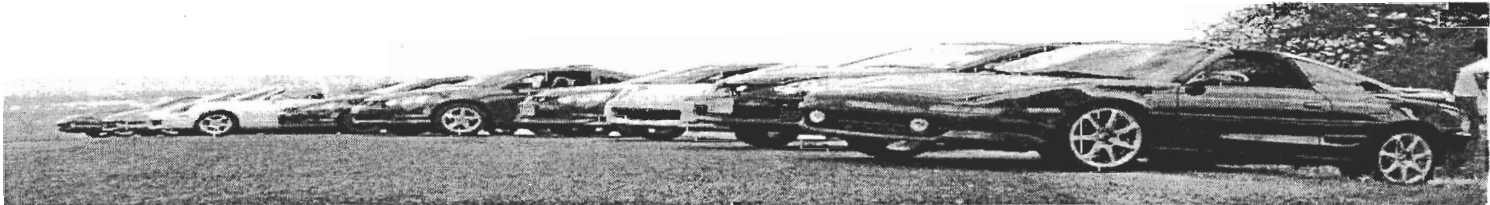
Since the end of 1998. I've been the Board of Directors, for the past three years.

- 3) How long have you been a member of Spokes?

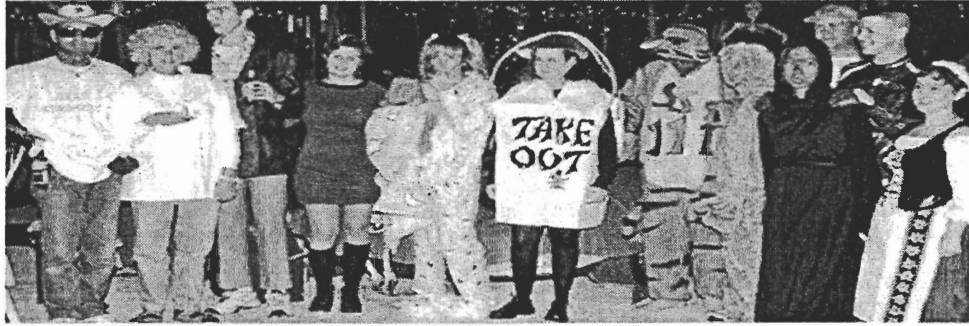

Tom Holt wrote the following breakdown of the basic rules and tips: "As for what works and what doesn't. It all boils down to one thing....Minimal rolling resistance. A fancy CNC machined frame doesn't work any better than a chunk of pine (but it looks a lot cooler). For the super mod class you need good bearings and straight axles and wheels. Wheel diameter doesn't seem to matter nor does wheel mass. Beyond that, you need to figure it out yourself! We don't want to give away our prep secrets...If you are interested in building a stocker, a quick search of the web will get you hundreds of sites on how to build them". 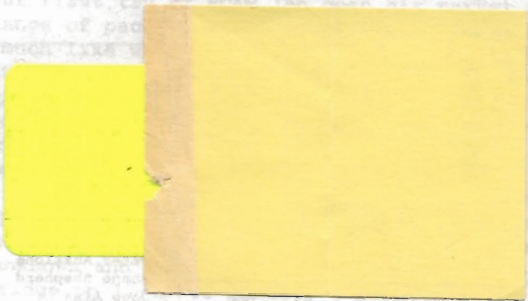
